

# **Dependence Forming Medications -** High quality e-learning courses from PrescQIPP



This e-learning course designed for medicines management teams, GPs, practice nurses, practice pharmacists and non-medical prescribers covers the statistics around the use of dependence forming medications, including modules on opioids, benzodiazepines & z-drugs and gabapentin & pregabalin.
